He stated that as a result of the Section 114, the bus serving the rural communities would cease as of April but that the closures of libraries had been halted.</p> <p>The Chair referred to correspondence from Wilbarston Parish Council gauging interest from local parishes with regards to looking at options to fund a community bus service for a once a week return trip to Corby and/or Market Harborough. The Council agreed that this would not be of sufficient interest to parishioners, on the basis that only one or two people use the existing service and it therefore could not justify a subsidy using public money.
